STEINER, QUICK AND WHEELER TOP PODIUMS AT BROOME-TIOGA WINTER SERIES

Hurd Motorsports, promoters of the world class Broome-Tioga Sports Center facility, hosted the fourth round of the fifth season of their Winter Mud and Snow Scrambles Series. The series consists of ten rounds running from November thru April utilizing the multiple motocross tracks, grass track and single track trails of this massive facility. The series continues expand and has been attracting new racers to this unique and challenging series but also continues to attract some of the most experienced and talented off-road riders from upstate New York and beyond.

Round four dawned under overcast skies and fairly mild temperatures for January. The forecast reported a high of 43 degrees for the day. Early morning rain showers made track conditions wet, muddy and slippery. There was still some icy spots lurking under the mud but once the ice began to thaw, track conditions got even muddier.

When the green flag dropped for the start of the Un-studded motorcycle scramble, Tim Steiner, James Steiner and Jesse Stollman led the pack out of the first turn and onto the racecourse.

When the leaders exited the scoring area at the start of the second lap, James Steiner had taken the lead and built an eight second lead over Tim Steiner in second. Dan Warner, Stollman, and David Searles rounded out the top five.

Tim Steiner re-took the lead before the start of lap three and had a seven second lead. James Steiner, Warner, Stollman and Searles rounded out the top five.

Steiner held on and took the checkers and the win with a three second lead. James Steiner, Warner, Stollman and Jacob Knapp completed the top five.

When starter threw the green flag to start the Plus 30 Expert motorcycle scramble, Craig Evans, Matthew Quick, Ken Chamberlin and Joshua Ackley led the pack out of the first turn and onto the racecourse.

By the end of the opening lap, Evans continued to lead and started lap two with a six second advantage. Ackley, Quick, Chamberlin and Daniel Conway rounded out the top five.

When the leaders exited the scoring area at the start of lap three, Quick had taken over the lead and was followed by Evans, Ackley, Chamberlin and Eric Barrett.

Quick took the checkered flag for the win with a ten second lead. Evans, Ackley, Chamberlin and Barrett closed out the top five.

When the leaders entered the motocross section of the course at the end of the first lap, Nicholas Wheeler held the point position and was followed by Thierfelder, Hoffman, Bidlack and Tim Steiner.

Wheeler remained out front at the start of lap three and had a whopping 22-second advantage over Thierfelder in second. Bidlack remained third and trailed Thierfelder by three seconds. Hoffman, in fourth, was five seconds behind Bidlack. Steiner continued to hold fifth.

Wheeler started the fourth lap with an 18-second lead. Bidlack, Hoffman, Steiner and Thierfelder rounded out the top five.

Wheeler cruised to the Open Amateur win and took the checkers with a 27-second lead. Bidlack, Hoffman, Steiner and Thierfelder completed the top five.
