KENYON, SCUTT-CORNELL TOP PODIUMS AT BROOME-TIOGA WINTER SERIES

Hurd Motorsports, promoters of the world class Broome-Tioga Sports Center facility, hosted the sixth round of the fifth season of their Winter Mud and Snow Scrambles Series. The series consists of ten rounds running from November thru April utilizing the multiple motocross tracks, grass track and single track trails of this massive facility. The series continues expand and has been attracting new racers to this unique and challenging series but also continues to attract some of the most experienced and talented off-road riders from upstate New York and beyond.

Round four dawned under sunny skies and fairly mild temperatures for February. The forecast reported a high of 39 degrees for the day. As the temperature rose the track began to thaw and the muddy conditions became a factor, making visibility difficult. The muddy conditions made identifying riders difficult as well.

When the green flag flew to the start of the Novice motorcycle scramble, Brandon Kenyon, Michael Law, Michael Puglese and Eric Adams led the pack out of the first turn and onto the racecourse.

When the leaders exited the scoring area at the start of the second lap, Kenyon continued to lead and was followed by Andrew Gray, Brandon Karp, Kyle Beadle and Deekon Flint.

Kenyon continued to lead the Novice division scramble at the start of the third lap and continued to add to his already extensive lead, which was now an astounding 1 minute and 36 seconds over Gray in second. Puglese, in third, was 24-seconds behind Gray and Beadle and Karp rounded out the top five.

Kenyon continued pulling away and took the checkered flag with a 3 minute lead. Gray, Law, Beadle and Karp completed the top five.

When starter threw the green flag to start the Expert/AA motorcycle scramble, Alex Dzikiewicz, Marcus Scutt-Cornell and Ian Howes led the pack out of the first turn and onto the racecourse.

By the end of the opening lap, Scutt-Cornell had taken over the lead with Dzikiewicz only three seconds behind in second. James Steiner Jr., Joshua Ackley and Daniel Boehme rounded out the top five.

The battle for the lead continued on lap three between Scutt-Cornell and Dzikiewicz. Only two and a half seconds separated the two. Steiner, in third, was still closed enough to the leaders to become a threat for the win if either of the leaders made a mistake. Ackley and Andrew Gross rounded out the top five.
