GRAY AND WITTMER TOP PODIUMS AT FINAL ROUND OF THE BROOME-TIOGA WINTER SERIES

Hurd Motorsports, promoters of the world class Broome-Tioga Sports Center facility, hosted the final round of the fifth season of their Winter Mud and Snow Scrambles Series. The series consists of ten rounds running from November thru April utilizing the multiple motocross tracks, grass track and single track trails of this massive facility. The series continues expand and has been attracting new racers to this unique and challenging series but also continues to attract some of the most experienced and talented off-road riders from upstate New York and beyond.

Mother Nature provided a beautiful spring day for the final round of the series that consisted of beautiful blue skies, abundant bright sunshine, temperatures in the mid-sixties and a nice breeze. The Broome-Tioga track groomed the motocross portion of the racecourse to perfection but there were still some slightly wet and muddy spots in the woods sections that kept racers on their toes.

When the green flag flew to the start of the Over 40 Amateur/Novice motorcycle scramble, Pat Keogh, Toby Logue, Bryan Gosman, John Desousa and Dan Woodger led the pack out of the first turn and onto the racecourse.

When the leaders re-entered the motocross section of the course near the end of the first lap, Scott Gray was out front with the lead and had an eleven second advantage over Jerry Roys in second. Logue, Keogh and Gosman rounded out the top five.

Gray continued to hold the point position at the start of lap three. Roys, in second, had closed the gap on Gray, reducing his lead to five seconds. Logue continued to hold thirs. Gosman moved up to take fourth and Keogh dropped back to fifth.

By the start of the fourth lap, Gay's lead had increased to 18-seconds over Roys in second. Logue remained all alone in third. Keogh had moved back into fourth and Woodger fifth. Gosman was relegated to sixth.

Gray took the checkers and the win with a whopping 49-second lead. Roys, Logue, Woodger and Keogh completed the top five.

When starter threw the green flag to start the Novice motorcycle scramble, Andrew Gray, Michael Puglese, Kyle Beadle, Britni Santee and Eric Engstrom led the thirty one rider field out of the first turn and onto the racecourse.

When the leaders entered the scoring area at the start of lap two, Gray remained out front and had a ten second advantage over Engstrom in second. Baedle, TJ Wittmer and Puglese rounded out the top five.

Gray remained in the lead at the start of lap three and had Engstrom right on his rear tire. Less than two seconds separated the two. Wittmer passed Beadle to secure third. Beadle was relegated to fourth and Tyler Kundrata rounded out the top five.

Wittmer was working his way through the pack and had taken the lead by the start of lap four. Engstrom continued to hold second. Gray dropped back to third. Beadle and Scott Kramer completed the top five.

Wittmer held on and took the checkered flag and the win with a three second lead. Engstrom, Gray, Beadle and Kramer closed out the top five.
