## STRYKER, THOMAS TOP PODIUMS AT BROOME-TIOGA WINTER SERIES

Hurd Motorsports, promoters of the world class Broome-Tioga Sports Center facility, hosted the opening round of the fifth season of their Winter Mud and Snow Scrambles Series. The series continues to grow and now consists of ten rounds running from November thru April utilizing the multiple motocross tracks, grass track and single track trails of this massive facility. The series continues expand and has been attracting new racers to this unique and challenging series but also continues to attract some of the most experienced and talented off-road riders from upstate New York and beyond.

Round one dawned under overcast skies and chilly temperatures in the mid to upper 40's with a brisk wind that made it feel much colder. Mother Nature attempted to help by throwing in some occasional sun shine throughout the day and by late afternoon the sun began to shine in as daylight began to fade now that daylight savings time had expired. Track conditions were excellent and no studded tires were needed for the opening round of the series.

When the green flag dropped for the start of the Super Open motorcycle scramble, Alex Dzikiewicz, Marcus Scutt Cornell, Michael Kenyon and Kyle Willis led the pack out of the first turn and onto the racecourse.

When the leaders reentered the motocross section of the racecourse near the end of the opening lap, Scutt Cornell had taken over the lead and was followed Dzikiewicz, Willis, Mike Stryker and Spencer Hoyt.

By the start of the third lap, Stryker had worked his way to the front and had taken the lead with Dzikiewicz a close second. Scutt Cornell, Willis and Hoyt rounded out the top five.

Stryker continued to hold the point position at the start of lap four while Willis battled with Dzikiewicz and made the pass to take second. Dzikiewicz was relegated to third. Scutt Cornell and Hoyt continued to hold fourth and fifth.

## Binghamton, New York, November 7, 2015

Stryker continued to lead for the next two laps and took the checkered flag for the win with a three second lead. Dzikiewicz, Willis, Hoyt and Scutt Cornell completed the top five.

When the green flag dropped for the start of the AA/Expert division bike scramble, Marcus Scutt Cornell, Ian Howes, Matthew Quick, Spencer Hoyt and Schae Thomas led the pack out of the first turn and onto the racecourse.

When the leaders were finishing up the final motocross section just before the scoring area at the end of the first lap, Thomas had worked his way into the lead and was followed by Mike Stryker, Dzikiewicz, Scutt Cornella and Kenyon.

By the start of lap three, Thomas and Stryker had checked out and had a very sizable lead as the gap back to Dzikiewicz continued to grow. Scutt Cornell and Willis rounded out the top five.

Thomas continued to hold the lead for the next two laps and started the white flag lap with a nine second lead over Stryker in second. Thomas seemed to back off his pace a bit and cruised to the win with a five second lead. Stryker finished second. Dzikiewicz, over a minute behind Stryker took third. Willis and Scutt Cornell completed the top five.
